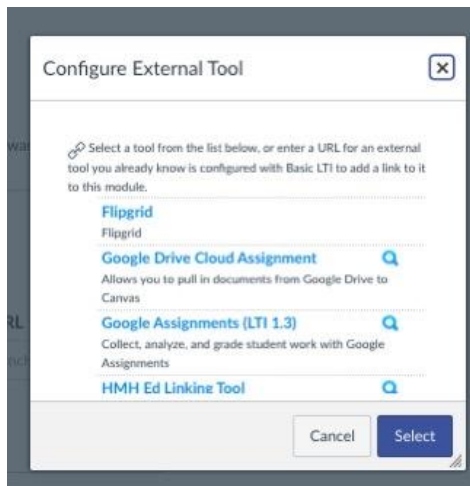


Canvas and Google

Currently, instructors can integrate Google assignments into Canvas using the following 2 options:

1. Google Drive Cloud Assignments
2. Google Assignments LTI 1.3

When you create a Canvas assignment and choose “External Tool” as the submission type, you will currently see both as options.



Canvas and Google no longer support “Google Drive Cloud Assignments” and it will eventually no longer be a choice. It is still available and you can still use it in your course at this time, but we will get no support from either company if any tech issues arise. We are encouraging all staff who would like to integrate Google into their Canvas courses to begin using the new Google Assignments LTI 1.3.

What can you do with Google Assignments LTI 1.3?

- A. Use Google Assignments to distribute, collect, grade and return student work.
- B. Embed Google Drive files anywhere the Rich Content Editor exists in Canvas, like announcements, assignments, pages, or discussions.
- C. Create a standard Canvas assignment with online submission enabled so students can submit files from their Google Drive.
- D. Works with Google Docs, Google Sheets, and Google Slides.
